
In the Government Order first cited, the Government have issued orders about the detailed Code of Conduct governing the relationship between the Members of Parliament / Members of State Legislatures and the Government Servants.

2. Despite these instructions, it has been brought to the notice of the Government by the Government of India, in the D.O letter 2nd cited, that District Officials have not been showing due respect and courtesy to the Members of Parliament / Members of State Legislatures and the Committee of Privileges of Lok Sabha recommended consolidation and reiteration of the existing instructions relates to the official dealings between administration and Members of Parliament / Members of State Legislatures. It has therefore been decided to reiterate the instructions, issued in the Government Order first cited.

3. All Departments of Secretariat and Heads of Departments are requested to instruct all the Subordinate Officers under their control to follow the instructions issued in G.O.Ms.No.250, Personnel and Administrative Reforms (A) Department, dated 11.06.2004. In addition to that, all District Magistrates, Collectors and Superintendents of Police to review periodically in the conference regarding the disposal of the petitions received from Members of Parliament / Members of State Legislatures without fail.

4. The Personnel and Administrative Reforms (Inspection) Department are also instructed to watch the implementation of G.O.Ms.No. 250, Personnel and Administrative Reforms (A) Department, dated 11.06.2004 at the time of inspection.
