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### **ORDER:-**

With a clear objective of implementing special programmes of the Government expeditiously, the Government have in their order read above created a new Department called Special Programme Implementation Department. The Department coordinates with the concerned Departments to expedite implementation of the important schemes/programmes of the Government. This Department also provides necessary feedback to the Government on the qualitative and quantitative aspects of the schemes by organizing frequent tours / visits by the Officers of this Department and also has to suggest corrective course of action to the Government wherever necessary.

2. The Government have announced several flagship schemes, programmes and projects for socio-economic development of the State and to fulfill long felt needs of the people. Some of these schemes are as indicated below :

<b>Sl. No</b>	<b>Scheme</b>
1.	Free Distribution of 4 grams Gold for Thirumaangalyam (Sacred Thread) and marriage assistance of Rs.25,000/- (poor woman), Rs.50,000/- (educated woman). Differently abled girls too can benefit from this scheme.
2.	Monthly Pension of Rs.1000/- to Senior Citizen, Differently abled persons and destitute woman and widows in Tamil Nadu.
3.	Free LAPTOP to be given to 9.12 lakhs students @ cost of Rs.912 crores.
4.	Free Distribution of Fans, Mixies and Grinders to 25 lakhs women @ cost of Rs.1250 crores.

<b>Sl. No</b>	<b>Scheme</b>
5.	Free Distribution of 60000 milch cows within 5 years to poor rural families. 12000 milch cows will be given during this year @ Rs.56 crores.
6.	Free Distribution of 4 Goats or Sheep each to 7 lakhs poor families in 5 years. Out of which, 1 lakh will be given this year @ Rs.135 crores.
7.	Construction of 60000 Green Houses @ Rs.1080 crores.
8.	Chief Ministers Comprehensive Health Insurance Scheme @ Rs.750 crores.
9.	Four Sets of Free Uniforms to Elementary School Children. For 6 <sup>th</sup> standard and above, Full pants for Boys and Salwar-Kameez to Girls will be given.

3. The Government consider that the special programmes/ schemes/projects of the Government have to be closely monitored and the progress of those schemes/programmes/projects have to be reviewed at Government Level periodically.
